

REGULATION CAMPSITE KALANDRA CHALKIDIKI

- May September 2018-

1. Campers when entering the Campsite are obliged to hand over their Passport or Identity Card and the Card of the Campsite, if they possess one.
2. On the day of departure the Customer is allowed to remain in rented space until **14:00** hours. For late departure beyond the specified hours Campers must pay for the night if they choose to stay.
3. During the siesta hours from **14:30 to 17:00** and from **24:00 to 07:00**, every Camper is obliged not to disturb and to respect the privacy of others.
4. The Campers must be careful not to cause damage to the Campsite facilities or equipment. Campers are also kindly requested not to damage the lawn. In case of damage to facilities or equipment the Customer is obliged to pay the cost of the damage repairs.
5. The outer door closes exactly at **24:00** and opens at **07:00**. During the hours of **24:00 to 07:00** the movement of any vehicle in Campsite (Car - Motorcycle - Bicycle) is prohibited. Nobody is exempted from this rule – not even on special occasions.
6. **Visits** are allowed only after permission from Reception of the Campsite and after handing over the ID card or Passport. Visitors cars are not allowed to enter the Campsite. A visit at the Campsite should not exceed 2 hours and the number of people should be as limited as possible. After 1 hour and up to 6 hours visitors must pay for the day. After 6 hours and up to 24 hours visitors must pay for the night. If the visitor has no Identity Card, the customer Camper should produce his identity instead.

Entrance of visitors from the beach is prohibited. If visitors who have not checked – in at the Reception are found, the Management has the right to banish the client Camper from the Campsite.

7. The electricity consumption in positions of Caravans should be limited. The use of electric hob or electric ovens is strictly prohibited. For this purpose there are communal areas. The consumption of electricity will be checked by meters which are installed in every position.

8. Dogs must be tied and muzzled. Having dogs loose in the Campsite and the beach is strictly prohibited. If the dog disturbs Campers it must immediately be taken away. The care of stray dogs (animals) at the Campsite is also prohibited. Finally, animal owners should ensure that biological needs of animals to be outside the unit. If the Management finds that a dog is dangerous for the area and for Campers, the Customer will have to obey and take it away immediately. If they disobey, the Management has the right to banish the Camper from the Campsite.

9. Customers who belong to the Package category are allowed to use only one car when entering the Campsite which has been registered and uses the Entry Card. Second and third car is charged with a special charge from the Management. The maximum speed of vehicles in the Campsite is 10 km. In case of faster driving, the Entry Card will be taken away from the driver and he/she will no longer be allowed to enter the Campsite. Admission is also prohibited if the Guard discovers that the driver has consumed too much alcohol or used other substances.

The use of an entry Card by a car which is not registered will automatically lead to confiscation of the Card. The badge on the car is charged with a security deposit which is refunded at the end of the season with the return of the card. If the card is lost, the deposit amount is not refundable.

- 10.** Washing cars, boats and caravans in the unit is prohibited. It is only allowed in the space provided for washing.
- 11.** Boats and Surfing are not allowed in the area marked by buoys and the approach to the beach is only allowed through specific lanes where parking of boats is allowed too.
- 12.** The outdoor fire for cooking or other purposes is prohibited unless an appropriate device is used.
- 13.** The Management of the Campsite is not responsible for the loss of items due to theft or damage. The Campers should take care of their property themselves. Valuables can be given for safekeeping to the Management of the Campsite where there is a secure area.
- 14.** The Management of the Campsite is not liable for any damage, theft, fire caused in a Caravan, Trailer Tent or Tent in the Campsite during its operation or STORAGE period by third parties or weather conditions (flooding - thunder - fire – tree fall).
- 15.** The use of bicycles in the unit is allowed from **09:00 to 14:00** and from **17:00 to 21:00**. Parents are requested to ensure the application of this rule.
- 16.** Parents of minors are required to supervise their children at all times and protect them. In public places (shops – wc – shower – beach - golf) minors must be accompanied by their parents who are responsible for their behavior.
- 17.** Do not fence your premises with wires or ropes because it is extremely dangerous to your physical integrity, particularly for the elderly and young children. Customers must use the designated roads or access lanes to move around the Campsite.
- 18.** The position in which the Caravan or Tent is placed is indicated only by the Staff of the Campsite. It is also forbidden to change position without the prior approval of the Reception.

19. Please show particular sensitivity in public places (wc, shower, etc.) and do not unnecessarily consume hot water and electricity, because the excessive use leads to a significant reduction and degradation of the provided services.

20. The use of water hose for washing and watering trees and plants which are the responsibility of the Staff of Campsite is forbidden.

21. The person signing the Caravan placeholder Agreement is responsible for compliance with the regulation of all persons residing in the Caravan and has the obligation to notify them about all the terms of the regulation with which they need to comply.

22. The Director of Campsite has the right to ban the Campers that do not comply with the Campsite regulation or ignore the Management's admonitions to comply, from the Campsite or staying in the Campsite.

23. In any other case in which the Camp Management believes that Customer behavior is dangerous to the safety of others and to the smooth operation of the business, the Management has the sole authority to decide whether to admonish or banish the Customer.
