

RULES OF PROCEDURE FOR DAILY CAMPERS OF KALANDRA CAMPSITE 2019

1. The camper is obliged to deliver his/her passport or identity card when entering the campsite.
2. The campsite's reception operates from 07:00 till 23:00. Arrivals and departures are carried out from 08:00 till 22:00.
3. On the day of arrival, the customer can pick up the key of the cabin at 12:30. On the day of departure, the customer has the right to remain in the rented area (CABIN) until 10:30 when he/she will have to deliver the cabin in the condition s/he received it along with the equipment.
4. On the day of departure, the customer has the right to remain in the rented area (TENT) until 14:00. In the event of delay in the departure beyond this specific time, he/she will be required to pay for the cost of the overnight stay.
5. During quiet hours, from **14:30 till 17:00** and from **24:00 till 07:00** every camper is obliged not to disturb and respect the rest of the campers.
6. The camper is obliged to be careful so as not to cause any damage to the facilities or equipment. Everyone is kindly requested to be careful with the lawn, the trees and the natural environment. In the event of damage to the premises or equipment attributable to the camper, he/she shall be liable for the payment of the damage caused.
7. The gate **closes STRICTLY at 24:00** sharp and opens at **07:00**. During the hours from **24:00 to 07:00** it is forbidden to drive any vehicle within the campsite (car, motorbike, bicycle). There are no exceptions to the rule even if there is a special reason.
8. **Visits** are not allowed. Guests staying up to 4 nights can welcome visitors at the outdoor space where there is a leisure area. Guests staying for over 5 nights can only have visitors with the permission of the campsite's reception and after handing over an identity card or passport. The stay at the camping site should not exceed **1** hour and the number of people should be as limited as possible. After the **1st** hour and up to **6** hours, there will be a charge of a half-day price and after the 6th hour and up to 24 hours there will be a charge of an overnight stay.
9. Daily campers who have pets with them should have them tied and wearing a muzzle. Pets are not allowed to walk around the campsite, especially at the seaside area (it is also strictly forbidden to allow pets to swim in the sea of the campsite's area). If the pet is bothering other people, it should be taken away immediately. **Between 20/07 and 20/08, pets are not allowed due to the increased number of guests.**

10. The maximum speed of wheeled vehicles within the campsite is **5 km**. If a driver is driving at a higher speed, he will have his entry card **removed** and he will be allowed to enter the campsite only as a pedestrian. Access is also forbidden to any car driver who will be deemed by the guard to have consumed a significant amount of **alcohol** or other **substances**.

11. Lighting a fire in the open for barbecues or other purposes is strictly forbidden unless the appropriate device is in place.

12. The Management of the campsite will not be held responsible for the loss of objects due to theft or damage. Campers must take care of their own property. Items of value can be given for safekeeping to the campsite's Management where there is security area.

13. The campsite's Management cannot be held responsible for any failure, theft, damage, fire caused to the Tent within the campsite during the period of operation or GUARDING by a third person or by extreme weather conditions (flood, thunders, fire, fallen trees).

14. The hours for the riding of bicycles within the Unit have been set between 09:00 to 14:00 and 17:00 to 21:00. Parents are kindly requested to ensure that the above schedule is respected.

15. The place where the tent is placed is solely indicated by the campsite's staff. It is also forbidden to change the location of the tent without the prior approval of the reception.

16. We would like to ask you to be particularly careful when it comes to public areas (W.C., showers) and not to unnecessarily consume hot water and electricity since a wasteful use shall entail a noticeable reduction and degradation of the services provided.

17. In case the camper fails to observe the regulation in force and does not discipline himself with eventual observations or suggestions, the campsite's Management is entitled to forbid him from staying or entering the campsite as well as to have him/her removed from the campsite.

18. In any case in which the campsite's Management deems that the guest's behavior is dangerous to the safety of the rest of the guests and to the proper operation of the business, the Management shall be the sole authority to decide on any recommendations to be made to the guest or on the removal of the guest from the campsite.
